

<p>#1 - Ears of a toy dog</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • upright ears • rounded-tip ears • blunt ears • prick ears 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • large • oversized
<p>#2 - Feeler of an ant</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • antennae 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long • thin
<p>#3 - Ears of an elephant</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • fan-shaped ears • heart-shaped ears 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • large • massive
<p>#4 - Ears of a hound</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • floppy ears • droopy ears • pendant ears • drop ears 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long

<p>#5 - Beak of a heron</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • spear-like bill • pointed bill 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • thin, long • narrow • slender
<p>#6 - Muzzle of a bulldog</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • short snout • flews or chops • snub nose • turn-up or basket-handled arched 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • chubby cheeks • excess skin • thick, broad, pendent
<p>#7 - Muzzle of a lab</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • muzzle • snout • maw • also the covering for the mouth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • medium-length snout
<p>#8 - Beak of a toucan</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharp, curved beak or bill 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • thick • large • enormous

<p>#9 - Teeth of a bulldog</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • underbite • jagged 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • broad, thick, squared jaws
<p>#10 - Teeth of a hippo</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • canine tusks • incisor teeth • ivory canine teeth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • wide-opening mouth
<p>#11 - Teeth of a wolf</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • snarl • baring teeth • fangs 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long pointed teeth

<p>#12 - Teeth of a cat</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharp feline teeth • pointy teeth 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • long
<p>#13 - Eyes of a Jack Russell</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • squinty eyes or squint-eyed • partly closed eyes 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Narrow, small
