



Master kahoots with Play again

In order to complete the course assignment, you'll need to download the Kahoot! app to your iOS or Android device. You can find it in the **App Store** or on **Google Play**.

Here's a reminder of how to open a Kahoot! challenge with the assignment:


- After downloading the Kahoot! app to your mobile device, log in to your Kahoot! account - we need this info to be able to send you your diploma and badge!
- **2.** When prompted to open the assignment challenge, **click the**

- **URL** to open the challenge inapp, or enter the PIN manually
- 3. You'll then be able to accept the challenge and play the assignment, which is structured as a multiple-choice kahoot. You can do the assignment in short rounds, taking breaks in between, or all at once.

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"Play again" (formerly known as Ghost mode) is an alternative way to play kahoots that, as always, is competitive and fun but also helps reinforce learning through repetition.



After playing a live kahoot, you will have the option to play the same kahoot again - either live or as a student-paced challenge - to practice and improve your score. By clicking the **Play again** button, the same kahoot will be relaunched.

As well as your class, all players are joined by their 'ghosts'! These ghosts play the kahoot alongside live players. They represent the scores of the players from the previous kahoot, and their answers (and answer times) will be exactly the same as those the players attained in the previous kahoot. You'll also notice the Kahoot! lobby music changes to a retro, 8-bit sound.

Top tip!

When playing a kahoot again, be sure to have players use the same nickname as they did previously, so their scores can be easily compared.

Kahoot! Certified for schools

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Play again allows you to compete against your previous score for content mastery. In this way, it makes learning through repetition competitive and fun: players will be focused on competing with themselves rather than others. This also helps create a feeling of accomplishment and builds confidence when players beat their previous scores and master the content.


How to access Play again

You can access the Play again feature in two different ways:

► When you finish a live kahoot, you will see the 'Play again' button. By clicking the button, you'll launch the same game again.



▶ When accessing the report for a live kahoot or student-paced challenge, click on the three-dot dropdown next to an individual game report. Here, you'll also find the Play again button. You can replay a live kahoot as a student-paced challenge and vice versa.



Using Play again to master content

Now you understand how Play again works, let's explore some ways you can use it to master content.

- 1. Master it quickly Using the Play again button on the final screen, play again immediately after a live kahoot to reinforce knowledge with repetition.
- 2. Group battles use Play again with a different group of students from the first one: so one group plays against the results of a previous group. A study group can challenge other groups to spark healthy competition.
- 3. Time is a great teacher Using Play again on the results page, get students to play against the ghosts of a kahoot played at the beginning of the topic or learning unit to measure progress over time. Don't forget to ensure they use the same nicknames to track improvement!
